## Congressional French Caucus Members in 116th Congress

Founded in 2003, the French Caucus is a bicameral, bipartisan congressional member organization, dedicated to promoting partnership and cooperation, enhancing U.S.-French relations in all fields, and facilitating a better understanding of the essential relationship between our two nations. Co-chaired in the U.S. Senate by Senators Boozman and Coons, and in the U.S. House of Representatives by Reps. Keating, Latta, Schiff, and Wilson, the French Caucus has been instrumental in providing opportunities for caucus members and staff to meet with visiting French delegations, as well as opportunities to travel to France to meet with French officials. Caucus members welcomed French President Macron to the U.S. Congress in April 2018 when he addressed a Joint Meeting of the Congress. In addition, they have travelled to France to meet with the French President and Members of Parliament, hosted meetings in Washington, D.C. for their counterparts in the French Senate and National Assembly, discussed bilateral economic and commercial ties, and commemorated the 60<sup>th</sup>, 65<sup>th</sup>, 70<sup>th</sup> and 75<sup>th</sup> anniversaries of D-Day. In 2017, in conjunction with the French Senate, the French Caucus Co-Chairs and other caucus members introduced a resolution to commemorate the centennial of the U.S. entry into World War I.
